

Hayl This Indenture made and entered into this 24th
 Go day of November A. D. 1857 between Mrs Hayl
 Elliott of the first part and Lindsey H. Elliott of the
 second part Witnesseth that whereas the said Lind-
 sey H. Elliott has become the security for the
 said William Hayl on a note for seventy five
 dollars dated the 12th day of November 1857
 and payable the first day of January 1859 to
 William Baker and also another note for
 fifty dollars bearing even date herewith and
 payable the 1st day of January 1859 to said Mr
 Baker, now the said Mrs Hayl being an-
 xious to secure the said L. H. Elliott against
 any loss as his security aforesaid Now therefore
 in consideration of the premises and in con-
 sideration of the sum of one dollar to him
 in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged the said party of the first part
 hath this day bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth bargain sell and convey un-
 to the said Lindsey H. Elliott one bay horse
 one bridle and pair of martingalls to have
 and to hold forever in trust however upon
 the following conditions that if the said
 Hayl shall pay off and satisfy said notes
 when they fall due and protect the said
 L. H. Elliott against any liability as his
 said security then this conveyance to be
 void and of no effect. But if said Mrs
 Hayl shall fail to pay said notes above
 described by said 1st January 1859 then
 the said L. H. Elliott shall have power

and is hereby authorized to take possession of said horse
Bridle & martingales and after giving ten days no-
tice of the time and place of sale proceed to sell said horse
bridle and martingales at public outcry for cash
and with the proceeds of said sale pay off said notes with
interest thereon and the expenses of this conveyance.
