 taining One hundred and forty six acres more or less  
 to have and to hold said tract of land to said Horace  
 Ware his heirs and assigns forever and we the said

 sent and by these Presents will now depart the title  
 title of said tract of land to said Horace Ware  
 his heirs and assigns against all persons whatever  
 in witness of all of which we hereunto set our hands
