

This Indenture made and entered into this 26 day  
 of October 1857 between Sally B. Wood and Richard  
 Wood husband and Wife of the first part and And-  
 rew B. S. Masely of the second part Witnesseth that  
 the said parties of the first part for and in consid-  
 eration of the love and affection which the said  
 party of the first part hath to the said party of the  
 second part hath sold and lawfully sell, affirms  
 and conveys to the said Andrew B. S. Masely  
 the following described lands to wit the North  
 East quarter of Section Seventeen (17) and  
 the West half of the North West quarter and  
 the North East quarter of the North West quarter  
 of Section Sixteen (16) all in Township Twenty

Grant (24) of Range Twelve (12) East in the Sixth  
 Alabama Land District Lyngan Shelly County State  
 of Alabama Containing two hundred and eighty  
 acres more or less to have and hold to the said  
 Andrew B. S. Morley his heirs and assigns forever  
 with the reservation only the Sally B Wood is to  
 have hold and enjoy the use occupation rents  
 and profits of said land, during her natural  
 life and the intention and design of this conveyance  
 are to convey to and vest in the said  
 Andrew B. S. Morley the title to said land to  
 become absolute in the death of the said Sally B  
 Wood and the said party of the first part hereby  
 Covenant with the said party of the second part  
 that the said Sally B Wood is lawfully seized of &  
 has good right to sell and convey said land, the  
 said Richard Wood joining in this conveyance  
 only as husband and as such to enable the Sally  
 B his wife to convey her said land as fully as tho  
 ugh she were a feme sole given under our hands  
 and seals this day and year above written—
