M. McCreas lot on which he now resides & with a front of one hundred & twenty one yards on the Kymulgee road from Columbiana and running back from said road in a North West ~~road~~ direction parallel with said McCreas lot one hundred & sixty three and also that portion of the North East fourth of North West fourth of Section twenty five in same Township & Range lying North West of said Kymulgee road & East of the above described four acre lot the lot here conveyed containing about twenty one acres more or less to have & to hold to said second party his heirs & assigns forever The above described and hereby granted premises. And the said parties of the first part husband & wife hereby covenant with the said party of the second part that we are lawfully seized of and have a good right to sell & convey said land and hereby bind ourselves our heirs and legal representatives forever to warrant and defend the title to said land and premises to the said party of the second part his heirs assigns and legal representatives against the claim of all and every person in law or Equity and against the government of the United States
