 witnesseth That whereas the said party of the first part
 is justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of
 Forty five one of promisory note for Forty Five dollars
 dated Jan 15th 1858 and payable on or before the 25th
 day of December 1858 and the said party of the 1st part being
 desirous to secure the payment of said indebtedness for & in
 consideration thereof and for the further consideration of the
 sum of one Dollar to the said party of the 1st part in
 hand paid by the said party of the ~~1st~~ part. The receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said party of the
 first part has sold and hereby sells and conveys to the
 said party of the second part the following described
 property one Bay horse with one eye about ten years
 old to have & to hold in trust as follows It is agreed that
 that the said party of the first is to have & retain possession
 of said property until the 25th day of December 1858
 And if the said party of the first part shall fully pay to
 the said party of the second part said debt with interest thereon
 and the reasonable expenses hereof by said 25th day of Dec 1858
 then this indenture is to be null & void But upon default of
 such payment the said party of the 2nd part is hereby
 authorized to take into possession and sell said property
 to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice of
 the time & place of said sale by advertisement posted up at
 three public places and out of the proceeds of said sale
 retain the said sum of Forty five dollars and interest
 thereon and the reasonable expenses hereof and the balance
 if any pay to the said party of the first part
