belonging to the above described property now in the possession of the above
named party of the first part now if the above named party of the
first fails to discharge the above named debt by the first day of
April 1858. He shall be lawful for the said party of the second part
to take into their possession the above described property and cause
the same to be advertised and sold by a lawful officer in testimony
