This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of February AD 1858 between Jefe Rivers debtor of the first part William M. Allen Trustee of the second part and the firm of Allen Rushing & Sawyer of the third part all of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama Witnesseth that whereas the said Jefe Rivers is justly indebted to the said firm of Allen Rushing & Sawyer in the sum of One hundred & twenty Three \$100 dollars due 1st January 1858 for Merchandise in 1856 & 1857 the same being an account which said indebtedness the said Jefe Rivers is anxious to secure Now Therefore in Consideration of said premises & for in Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid the said party of the first part hath bargained & sold & doth by these presents bargain sell and convey unto the said William M. Allen One two horse wagon & set of Harness to have and to hold to the said William M. Allen in trust upon the following Conditions that if said Jefe Rivers shall pay said debts above specified and the interest thereon by the 1st day of September next then this conveyance to be void but should the said Jefe Rivers fail to pay said indebtedness by the said 1st day of September next then the said Wm M Allen shall be authorized to take possession of said wagon & Harness and after giving ten days notice of the time & place of selling sell said wagon & Harness at public outcry for cash & with the proceeds of said sale pay off said indebtedness herein above specified interest thereon & the expenses of this conveyance and the Residue if any pay over to the said Rivers - In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals the day and year above written Jefe Rivers (Seal)
