 25 1858 and the said party of the first part being desirous
 to secure the payment of said indebtedness hold said Leonard
 harmless for & in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said
 party of the first part in hand paid by the said party of the 2nd
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said party
 of the first part has sold and hereby sells & conveys to the said
 party of the second part the following described property and
 one dark bay mare the same which I this day purchased
 from Willah Seal to have & hold in trust as follows
 It is hereby agreed that the said party of the first part is to
 have & retain possession of said property until the 25th day of
 December 1858. and if the said party of the first part shall
 fully pay the said debt with interest thereon and the reasonable
 expenses hereof by said 25th day of December 1858 then this
 indenture is to be null & void But upon default of such
 payment the said party of the second part is hereby authorized
 to take into possession and sell said property to the highest
 bidder for cash after giving twenty days notice of the time &
 place of said sale by advertisement posted up at three public places
 and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the said sum of
 one hundred & one \$5000 dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable
 expenses costs hereof - And the balance of any pay to the said party of the
 1st part
