and each of our right title, interest estate claim and
demand both at law and in equity and as well in
possession as in expectancy of in & to the following de-
scribed tracts of land viz South East quarter Section
Twenty One and East half of Fractional Section Twenty 28
Eight and South East quarter of South West quarter of
Section Twenty Two all in Township Twenty Two (22) Range
Three West. also all of the North half of Fractional Section 22-34
Three lying South of Chocoma Creek, the West half of South 3
East quarter Section Three, the West half of South West quarter 3
Section Two, the North East quarter of North West quarter 2
Section Eleven (11) the North West quarter of South West 11
quarter Section (11) Eleven the North East quarter of North 11
East quarter of Section Ten, the North East quarter of 10
South East 1/4 Section Ten the South West quarter of South 10
East quarter Section Ten, the South East quarter of South 10
West quarter Section Ten. All in Township Twenty four 10
Range Twelve East Containing Eight hundred & twenty 24-126
