 this day bargained and sold and by these presents
 do bargain sell and convey unto the said
 Lucinda R. Vasser the South East fourth
 of Section fourteen Township twenty one
 West lying in said County and contain-
 ing one hundred and sixty acres more
 or less to have and to hold the same with all
 the privileges and appurtenances thereun-
 to belonging unto her the said Lucinda
 R. Vasser her heirs and assigns forever and
 we hereby covenant and agree with the
 said Lucinda R. that we are lawfully
 seized of the premises aforesaid and have

a good right to sell and convey the same and that we will warrant and defend the title to the same to her the said Lucinda B. her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims of any and all other persons whatever. Witness our hands and seals this 27 January 1858 Wilie H. Pope Seal
