 Shelby County } day of March 1858 Between
 William Vines & James A. Mullins creditors of the
 first part & Jonathan Gragg the debtor of the
 second part to Wit that the said Jonathan
 Gragg being justly indebted to the said Vines
 & Mullins to the sum of One hundred & thirty
 dollars secured by 4 promissory notes 3 of them
 for forty dollars each dated on the 2nd day
 of January 1858 & due on the 25th December 1858
 1 note for ten dollars dated the 6th day of
 March 1858 & due on the 25th Decr 1858 and
 the said Gragg being anxious & desirous to secure
 the same has this day bargained and sold and
 does by these presents bargain sell & convey to
 the said Vines & Mullins the following lot or
 parcel of land to Wit the S $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S $\frac{1}{4}$
 of Sec 30 17 in T 23 R 15 E also one acre & Wagon
 and pair of Oxen & entire cotton crop to be grown
 this year (1858) to have & to hold the same so as
 to secure the payment of said Notes & if default
 be made in the payment of said Notes at their
 maturity either in whole or in part then the
 said Vines & Mullins shall proceed to sell
 to the highest bidder for cash the aforesaid
 property and giving ten days notice by a duly
 authorized & after paying all the said Notes
 together with the expenses of sale and this
 conveyance pay over to the said Gragg or other
 person legally claiming under him the Residue
 if any nevertheless if all of said Notes be paid
 at their maturity then this obligation to be void
 & the wife to remain in full force & effect
