 day of March A. D. 1858 execute her note to

 by the nonpayment of said above named note

 this day bargained and sold to C. B. Metton
 his heirs and assigns one negro boy named An-
 drew about eight or nine years and one negro
 man named Gepe about forty eight or fifty
 years old to have and to hold the said bargained prem-
 ises forever in trust nevertheless and upon this
 understanding that the said Nancy H. Randall
 am to remain in quiet possession of
 said property until the above mentioned note
 shall become due and upon failure to dis-
 charge the same then the said C. B. Metton
 is hereby authorized to take and sell said
 property to the highest bidder for cash at
 public sale by giving thirty days notice
 by advertisement at Columbiana and
 Montevallo and apply the proceeds thereof

to the payment of said above described note for four hundred and ten dollars and the balance if any pay over to the said Nancy H. Randall but upon the payment and full satisfaction of said note then and in that case this conveyance trust to cease and be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue In witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight
