 wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions
 remainder and remainders rents issues and profits
 thereof And also all the estate right title interest
 property possession Claim and demand whatsoever
 as well in law as in equity of the said parties of the first
 part of in or to the above described premises with
 appurtenances And the said parties of the first part
 promise and agree to and with the said party of
 the second part that they have not done or suffered
 and act by means whereof the above mentioned
 & described premises or any part or parcel thereof
 now are or at any time hereafter shall or may be
 impeached charged or incumbered in any manner
