 gained sold and confirmed unto the said C. V. Lee
 and J. V. Meredith the following property to wit:
 the North half of the North East quarter and
 the North half of the North West quarter of
 Section ten Township twenty one Range three
 West in all one hundred and sixty acres also
 two horses two cows and calves and two cotton
 gins to have and to hold the above described prop-
 erty and effects to themselves and their heirs for-
 ever. The condition of this conveyance is such
 that if the said Dillon J. G. H. and Eli Sam-
 nelly shall well and truly pay the said C. V. Lee and
 J. V. Meredith the sum of five hundred and
 sixty four and 60/100 dollars with all in-
 terest costs and damages according to the
 tenor of said debt this Conveyance to be void
 else to remain in full force and the said C. V.
 Lee and J. V. Meredith shall at all times after
 the 25th of December next have power to take in-
 to possession and sell at public outcry after
 giving ten days notice the North half of the
