 Shelby County Alabama To wit beginning at the NW  
 corner of the lot on which Holloman now lives thence  
 E with the variation along the ~~boundary~~ <sup>boundary</sup> of said  
 lot to the ~~original~~ <sup>original</sup> section line which is 25 poles &  
 ten feet thence N with said line 13 pole & 4 1/2 feet thence  
 W with the variation to the Yellow Leaf Road thence  
 down said road to the beginning being the lot now  
 occupied by H. N. Nabor to have & to hold ~~in~~ <sup>in</sup> ~~trust~~  
 to said second party his heirs & assigns forever  
 the above described land hereby granted premises  
 And the said parties of the first part husband  
 & wife hereby covenant with the said party of the  
 second part that we are lawfully seized of and have  
 good right to sell & convey said land and hereby  
 bind ourselves our heirs and legal representatives  
 forever to warrant and defend the title to said  
 land & premises to the said party of the second
