 of Cuska-loosa Alabama for the consideration
 of the sum of fifty seven dollars to us in hand

 is hereby acknowledged by the first part in con-
 sideration of which said first part have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant
 bargain and sell to the aforesaid Michael

Harr and to his heirs forever the land aforesaid to have and to hold and we James Harr and Mary Harr his wife of the first part will forever warrant and defend the title for the sum for said land to him the said Michael Harr and to his heirs forever in witness whereof we have herewith set our hands and seals this 1st day of March A.D. 1858
