 and assigns that we are lawfully seized in
 fee of the aforegranted premises that they are
 free from all encumbrances that we have
 a good right to sell and convey the same to
 the said Hiram Butter his heirs and assigns
 and we will warrant and defend the premises
 to the said Hiram Butter his heirs and assigns
 forever against the lawful claims and de-
