This deed made and entered into this sixteenth day of April 1868 between Thomas B. Scroggins of the first part and Edward King of the second part and French & Nobors of the third part all of Shelby County Alabama.

Witnesseth that this said Thomas B. Scroggins is justly indebted to said King the sum of forty three dollars 25/100 by a promissory note bearing even date with these presents and due the first day of January next and the said Scroggins being desirous to secure the payment of said debt when the same becomes due as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to him so hand paid doth grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Nobors his heirs and assigns one Bay horse three years old and one two horse

waggon to have and to hold unto the said Robor,
 his heirs and assigns but trust nevertheless of the
 said Scroggins shall well and truly pay or
 cause to be paid the said sum of forty three ~~35~~¹⁰⁰
 when the same shall become due but on fail-
 ure thereof the said Robors is hereby authorized
 and empowered upon giving twenty days notice
 by advertisement at three public places in said
 County to seize and take possession of said
 horse and Waggon and sell the same or so much
 thereof as may be necessary to satisfy said debt
 and all costs and expenses that may accrue
 in carrying into effect the object of this deed
 at public auction for cash at the town of Elton
 Tevalo and appropriate the proceeds of said sale
 to the payment of said debt and cost and expenses
 and it is agreed by the said parties to this deed
 that the said Scroggins shall retain the use
 and the possession of said property until default
 be made in the payment of the said debt or
 any part thereof and if any the remainder to
 pay over to the said Scroggins. In witness where-
