The State of Alabama, This Indenture
 Shelby County I made and entered
 into this second day of April A.D. 1888
 between Abel Kindrick Debtor of
 the first part and B. B. Rushing Cred-
 itor of the second part Witnesseth. That
 whereas the said party of the first part
 is justly indebted to said party of the
 second part in the sum of \$572.100
 dollars due by due judgment and
 payable on or before the 25 day of

December 1858 and the said party of the
 first part being desirous of securing
 the payment of said indebtedness for
 and in consideration thereof and
 for the further consideration of the
 sum of one dollar to the said party
 of the first part in hand paid by the
 said party of the second part the re-
 ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 the said party of the first part has sold
 and hereby sells and conveys to the said
 party of the second part the following
 described property to wit: the South half
 of the South East quarter of section 8 &
 7 and the North half of the North East
 quarter of section number nine
 in Township twenty Range one West ly-
 ing and being in Shelby County State
 of Alabama and Tuscaloosa Land dis-
 trict. To have and to hold in trust
 as follows. It is hereby agreed that
 the said party of the first part is to
 have and retain possession of the said
 property until twenty fifth day of De-
 cember 1858 and if the said party of
 the first part shall fully pay said
 debt with the interest thereon and the
 reasonable expenses hereof by said twen-
 ty fifth day of December 1858 then the
 indenture to be null and void. But
 upon default of such payment said
 party of the second part is hereby
 authorized to take into possession
 and sell said property to the highest
 bidder for cash after giving ten day
 notice of the time and place of sale
 by advertisement posted up at three
 public places and out of the proceeds
 of said sale retain the said sum of
 twenty five & 2/100 dollars and interest
 thereon and the reasonable costs hereof
 and the balance if any pay over to the
 said party of the first part. Given un-
