

Guy & Guy The State of Alabama, This Indenture made
 Shelby County } and entered into this 34th
 day of April 1868 between Amrod M. Guy
 and Robert Guy debtors of the first part and
 Robert B. Rushing Creditor of the second part
 Witneseth. Whereas the said party of the first
 part. is jointly indebted to the party of the sec-
 ond part in the sum of one hundred and eight
 dollars by promissory note made by the said A. M.
 Guy dated fourth January 1868 and payable
 twenty fifth December 1868 which is the said
 A. M. Guy's own debt and in the sum of
 fourteen \$4.00 dollars by promissory note dated
 tenth March 1868 due one day thereafter with
 interest from first January past which is
 the said Robert Guy's individual debt to said
 Rushing besides which each of the said par-
 ties of the first are desirous of making an
 account with Allen and Rushing in

their store for such goods as may be necessary
 not to exceed sixty dollars including Wm.
 Guy's account to date and the said party of the
 first part being desirous to secure the payment
 of said indebtedness for and in consideration thereof
 and for the further consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the said party of the first part
 in hand paid by the said party of the second part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 the said party of the first part has sold and
 hereby sells and conveys to the said party of the
 second part the following described property to
 wit the entire crop of corn and cotton that
 the said Wm. Guy and Robert Guy have
 or may plant grow raise and gather this present
 year being about thirty five acres of corn
 and about twenty of cotton on the land
 of said Rushing the interest in which corn
 and cotton of the said Wm. and Robert
 Guy being only one half the other half that
 may be made on said land of corn and cot-
 ton being already by contract the right
 of said Rushing & the said Rushing having
 furnished the said land and stock to culti-
 vate it with which said corn and cotton crop
 or interest therein of said Wm. and Robert
 Guy the said Rushing is to have and hold
 in trust as follows. It is hereby agreed that
 the said party of the first part is to have
 and retain possession of the said property
 until the twenty fifth day of December 1858
 and if the said party of the first part shall ful-
 ly pay to the said party of the second part
 said debt and interest thereon and such
 charges in the store of Allen and Rushing
 as may be made as above stated and the
 reasonable expenses hereof by said twenty
 fifth day of December 1858 then this indenture
 to be null and void. But upon default of such
 payment the said party of the second part is hereby
 authorized to take into possession and sell
 said property to the highest bidder for cash
 after giving ten days notice of the time and
 place of said sale by advertisement posted
 up at three public places and out of the
 proceeds of said sale retain the said sum
 of money and interest thereon and the res-

enable costs hereof and the balance if any pay
to the said party of the first part and it is es-
pecially agreed and understood also that for
any debt now due by said N. M. Guy to said
Rushing for family supplies and such as may
hereafter by him become due for provisions which
said Rushing may hereafter furnish said N. M.
Guy's family to enable the said N. M. Guy and
Robert Guy to make raise and gather said crop
is included in the terms of this deed of trust and
on non payment of which said Rushing may
also seize and sell said Corn and Cotton that
may be made raised and gathered as above speci-
