The State of Alabama, Know all men by these pres-
 ents that we George B. Shortridge
 and Elizabeth Shortridge wife of said George B. Short-
 ridge of the County and state aforesaid of the first part
 in consideration of the sum of nine thousand one
 hundred and sixteen dollars Cash in hand paid have bar-
 gained sold and granted and by these presents do bargain
 sell and convey to Abner G. McCraw and John E. Pres-
 tridge of the second part the following tracts or parcels
 of land lying and situated in Shelby County state
 of Alabama and described as follows to wit: The
 South East quarter Section twenty township twenty
 four Range fifteen East. The North East quarter
 of section twenty nine Township twenty four and Range
 fifteen East. The North East quarter of South East
 quarter of section twenty nine Township twenty
 four Range fifteen. The West half of North West
 quarter Section twenty eight and South West quar-
 ter of Section twenty eight and the South West
 quarter of the South East quarter of said twenty eight
 section and all of Township twenty four Range
 fifteen East. Also East half of the North West
 quarter section twenty nine and the West half
 of North West quarter and the North West quar-
 ter of the South West quarter of section twenty one
 The East half of North West quarter and the South
 East quarter of the South West quarter of Section
 twenty. The South East quarter of the South East
 quarter of section twenty eight. The West half of
 the North West quarter of Section thirty four and
 the North East quarter of Section thirty three
 The South half of North East quarter Section
 twenty all of same Township and Range as
 first stated to wit: Township twenty four and
 Range fifteen East to have and to hold to the
 said McCraw and Prestridge their executors ad-
 ministrators and assigns forever and the said
 George B. Shortridge for himself his heirs
 executors and administrators doth covenant
 with the said McCraw and Prestridge that he is
 lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforegranted
 premises or tract of land in Shelby County
 that they are free from all incumbrances
 and he has a right to sell the same and that
 he and his heirs executors administrators and
 assigns will and shall warrant and defend
 the title of the same to the said McCraw and
