This indenture made April 19. 1858 in the County of Shelly and the State of Alabama between Stephen L Passey of the first part and Bennett Davis of the 2 part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part in Consideration of the sum of forty dollars & fifty Cents to him duly paid by said and by these Present, does grant and Convey to said party of second part a Cert ain piece of land containing ten acres known as follows, the North West Corner of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec 3 T 19 R 2 E and fourteen head of Sheep and one dark horse with the appur tenances and all the Estate title and interest of said party of first part therein this grant is intended as a security for the payment of forty dollars and fifty Cents on the 25 day of December next with interest thereon which payment duly made well under the term herein made void and if default shall be in the payment of the principal or interest above mentioned then the said party of the second part and his assigns are hereby authorized to sell the premises above granted together with the other property or so much thereof as will be necessary to satisfy the amount then due and the Costs and Expenses allowed by law Witness whereof I have set my hand and seal the day and date above written Witness John P Elliott S L Passey Sent
