 1858 between Malory Gotthard and E H Sawyer Notary
 to that Malory Gotthard being duly indebted to said E H
 Sawyer in the sum of \$135 evidenced by a note

bearing date herewith payable and or before the 25th
 day of Decr next and the said Malory Gotthard being
 desirous to secure the payment of said debt for and
 in consideration of said indebtedness and the further consid-
 eration of one dollar to him in hand paid by said
 E H S the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by
 this day sold and conveyed with Conveys to said E H
 S the following described property to wit and open
 and the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 E of NW 1/4 Sec 7 T24 R14 E containing
 and hundred & nineteen 1/100 acres to have and to
 hold in trust as follows it is hereby agreed that the
 said Malory Gotthard is to retain the possession
 and use of said property until said 25th day of
 Decr next and if the said Malory Gotthard shall
 fully pay said debt and the expenses hereof then
 this obligation to be void but in default of such
 payment then the said E H Sanyer is hereby
 authorized to sell such property to the highest bidder
 for cash after giving 30th days notice by advertise-
 -ment posted up at three public places in
 Shelby County and out of the proceeds of said sale
 return the amount of said debt & interest there-
 on expenses hereof and the balance if any
 pay to said Malory Gotthard Given under
 my hand and seal this day and year above
 written the words containing one hundred & nineteen
 1/100 acres intended before signed by
