But if default be made in payment of said debt then said party of the 2nd part shall be authorized to sell and sell said Cow and Calf at public sale giving twenty days notice by advertisement at 3 public places and afterwards the proceeds of said sale first to the payment of the said debt and interest and then the costs of this trust and the remainder if any pay to the said party of the 1st part.
