 hundred and fifty dollars, due by 2 promissory notes
 twenty five dollars, to be due 25 December 1858,

 1859 and the said party of the first part being
 desirous to secure the payment of said indebtedness
 for and in consideration thereof and for the further
 consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said
 party of the 1st part in hand paid by the said party
 of the 2^d part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 edged the said party of the first part has sold
 and hereby fully and Conveys to the said party of
 the 2^d part the following described property viz
 the West half of the East half of the S E 1/4
 of Section 3 Township 21 Range 1 E Containing
 forty acres more or less. 21-16ast

To have and to hold in trust as follows, It is hereby agree
 d that said party of the 1st part is to have and return
 possession of said property until the 25 day of Dec
 1859 and if the said party of the first part shall
 fully pay to said party of the 2^d part said debt
 with interest thereon and the reasonable Expens
 es thereof by said 25 Dec 1859 then this Indenture
 to be null and void but upon default of such payment
 the said party of the 2^d part is hereby authorized to take
 into possession and sell said property to the highest
 bidder for Cash after giving twenty days notice
 of the time and place of said sale by advertisement
 posted up at three public places and out of the proceeds
 of said sale return the said sum of one hundred and
 fifty dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable
 Costs hereof and the balance of any sum to the said
 party of the first part given under our hands & seals
 this day and year above written and it is also
 agreed that this deed of trust may be closed
 by an atty in fact E G Larnley (LS)
