

This indenture made and entered into this
 5th day of July 1838 between Daniel McLeod ad-
 -ministrator of the Estate of Samuel Seer dec'd of
 the first part and Daniel McLeod as an
 individual of the second part voluntarily that
 by virtue of an order of Court of Probate Court
 of Shelby County State of Alabama upon the

petition of the party of the first part the said party of the first part sold the following described land a part of the real estate of the said Samuel Tice for the purpose of paying the debt of said estate to wit the South West Quarter of the South East fourth and the South half of the South West fourth of section fifteen and the South West fourth of the North East fourth of section twenty two all in Township twenty one of range 1 East and at said sale the said Daniel McLeod became the purchaser of said land for the sum of four hundred and twenty four dollars that said sale was reported to said probate Court and by said Court approved and the said purchase money having been fully paid and the same accounted for to said estate and all of which having been reported to said probate Court and in all things conforming by said Court and the said Adams being required by the final Order of said Court to convey to the purchaser the title to said lands now for and in consideration of said promises the said party of the first part hereby sells and conveys unto the said party of the second part all such right title and interest in and to said land as the said Samuel Tice died seized and possessed to the said party of the second part to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever given under my hand and seal this day and year above written Let Daniel McLeod
