This indenture made and entered into this 27th day of July 1858 between David A. Bearfield, debtor of the first part and Robt R Rushing creditor of the second part witnesseth that whereas the said party of the first part is justly indebted to the said Robt R Rushing in the sum of Forty Seven ⁷⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars being the amount of an account made by said D. A. Bearfield with the firm of Allen Rushing & Co since the first day of January last the payment of which said account the said Bearfield is anxious to secure to the said Robt R. Rushing now therefore in consideration of the premises and for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said party of the first part in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said party of the first part has this day and doth by these presents sell assign transfer and convey unto the said party of the second part all the amounts now due or to become due to the said party of the first part on the subscription list to a school being taught by said D. A. Bearfield in Township 22 Range 1 of Shelby County Ala to have & to hold to the said Rushing his assigns administrators &c in trust however upon the following creditors that if said Bearfield shall pay off and satisfy said debt above specified by the first day of January next then this conveyance to be void but shall he fail to pay said debt by said first day of January next then the said Rushing shall have power & is hereby authorized to collect said subscription and appropriate the money thereon when collected to the payment of said debt above specified the said Rushing being hereby authorized first to appropriate on said debt the amount of ~~assignment~~ of money which come to his hands as trustee of said Township which shall be due me as teacher of the school above mentioned.
