

This indenture made and entered into this by and
 between Thomas M. Adams of the first part
 Alberto Martin of the second part and Mitchell T.
 Porter of the third part all of the county of
 Jefferson and State of Alabama Witnesseth
 that whereas the said party of the first part is
 indebted to the ~~party~~ of the third part in the
 sum of one hundred dollars due by prom-
 -issory notes made on the 5th day of Sept 1854
 and due at the date thereof and whereas the
 said party of the third part is the security of
 the said party of the first part in six promissory
 notes as follows one for one hundred dollars
 payable to Richard Hudsons Adm'r of the

 next thereoft with interest from date one for one
 hundred dollars payable to Richard Hudson
 Guardian of the heirs of Hugh Coupland due
 23rd of August 1856 and one day after date one
 for fifty three ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars dated Jan 17th 1857 due
 1st Jan 1858 with interest ~~thereon~~ from date payable
 to James Burford one for eighty five dollars
 payable to James Burford dated 5th Sept 1856 and
 due 1st 1856 one for one hundred dollars
 payable to E. Noblesy Beck Esqr dated some time
 in Feb or March 1856 with interest from date & one
 for one hundred & forty two ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars payable to
 Wm. S. Mudd dated May the 26th 1856 and due one
 day after date and whereas the said party of the
 third part is also surety of the said party of the
 first part in his official bond as Justice of
 the Peace in the said County of Jefferson which
 is dated 23rd Sept 1856 & the penalty of which is one
 thousand dollars and whereas the said party of
 the first part is willing to secure the payment of
 the first aforesaid note and to indemnify and
 save harmless the said party of the third part as
 such surety as aforesaid now therefore for & in
 consideration of the premises and in further
 consideration of one dollar to him paid
 by the said party of the second part the said party of the first
 part hath given granted bargain sold & conveyed and doth
 by these presents give grant bargain sell & convey unto
 the said party of the second part his Successors and
 assigns forever all those tracts or parcels of
 land lying and being in the County of Shelby
 in said State known & described as follows, to-wit:
 The SW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ Sec 30 T18 R2 west the NW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ Sec 30
 T18 R2 W the SE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ Sec 25 T18 R3 W the NE¹/₄
 of SE¹/₄ Sec 25 T18 R3 W To have & to hold the above
 described tracts or parcels of land unto the said
 party of the second part his Successors and assigns
 in trust as follows To sell the same to the highest
 bidder for cash before the Court house door in the
 town of Corydon whereas called upon so to do
 by the said party of the third part having first
 given thirty days notice of the sale by written
 advertisement put at the public in said
 County of Jefferson and apply the proceeds
 of said sale to the payment of said notes and
 to refunding any amount the said party of the
 third part may have paid as surety on said
