love and affection which I bear to my son in law
Benjamin F Harris my son Jesse Overton my son
David Overton and the heirs of my son Jack
Overton deceased as well as for the further Consideration
of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by
the above named persons at as before the making
-ing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have given and granted and
by these presents do give and grant unto the
said Benjamin F Harris Jesse Overton David
Overton and the heirs of Jack Overton deceased
their executors Administrators and assigns
the following descended property to wit and negro
woman named Mariah and her Children
named Martha and their increase and all the
Horses Cattle pigs and all the money notes and evid-
-ences of debt &c that I now possess or may hereafter
acquire of said gift to take effect at my decease
to be sold by the said Jesse Overton and divided
between them so that the said Benjamin F Harris
shall receive one fourth the said Jesse Overton
one fourth the said David Overton one fourth and
the heirs of Jack Overton deceased one
fourth to have and to hold forever.

July in the Year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and forty eight
