 the 22nd of Sept 1838 } signed Thomas S H Robertson
 of the first part in presence of the second to secure to W R Rushie
 of the second part the payment of one note for
 ninety and 05/100 dollars to be paid as before
 the first of January next S H Robertson do give
 to the said Rushie a deed of trust upon one
 Colman Colored Horse with black mane and
 tail and if the above named note is not paid
 by the first of January next S H Robertson do by
 these presents vest said W R Rushie with the power
 to seize and sell to the highest bidder for cash the
 above described horse by giving ten days notice
 in three different places in presence of no less than
 seven in number my hand & seal the day & date above
 stated
