 Shelly County, 3 entered into this 24<sup>th</sup> day of  
 September and thousand eight hundred & fifty  
 eight between Elisha Parley of the first part and  
 W. M. Rodette of the second part all of the County  
 and State aforesaid Witnesseth that whereas the

Said party of the first part is lawfully indebted to said party of the second part in the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars due the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next and as said party of the first part is desirous and anxious to secure said party of the second part he has this day for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell a Certain Crop of Cotton and Corn planted and Cultivated by said Landry Containing eight acres more or less so as to include all the Cotton and Corn said Landry may raise or gather off of said the present Crop to have and to hold the same forever his heirs executors administrators and assigns from and upon these Conditions said Landry is to gather said Crop of Cotton and Corn and deliver the same to be delivered at his house on or by the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next then said party of the second part shall have power and is hereby authorized to proceed with his Wagon and carry the same to the Gin house of said party of the second part and said amount due said party of the second part is not satisfied on or by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1839 then said party have full power and is hereby authorized to advertise said Cotton and Corn for twenty days in three or more public places and on such day as advertised shall proceed to sell to the highest bidder for Cash sale to be at the Gin house of said party of the second part and if there shall be more than a sufficiency to satisfy said debt then said party of the second part shall pay or cause such surplus to be paid back to said party of the first part or his heirs executors administrators assigns For testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal day and year above written Elisha Lolley J.P.
