

This indentured made and undersigned made and
 entered into this 30th day of September AD 1838 between Eleanor
 B. Barnett a married woman holding a separate estate
 of the first part and Dixon McCleendon and Gordon
 Lewis of the second part witnesses that for and in
 consideration of the love and affection which the party
 of the first part has for his niece Eleanor McCleendon
 daughter of James & Nancy McCleendon and Eleanor Mc-
 Cleendon daughter of William & Nancy McCleendon & David
 Mahan and Erwin Mahan two sons of Joseph Mahan
 Lewis McCleendon and the further consideration of Ten
 dollars to the party of the first part in hand
 paid by the said parties of the second part the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said
 party of the first part have sold and hereby
 sell and convey to the said parties of the second
 part the following described land and improvements to
 wit the South half of Section (33) thirty three and
 33 W^{1/4} of the S^{1/4} of Section (33) thirty three E^{1/2} of the
 27+ 32 E^{1/4} of Section (32) thirty two S^{1/4} of Section (27) twenty
 34 seven and N^{1/4} of the N^{1/4} of Section 34 all in Town
 21-2 W
 = ship 21 of Range 2 West all that tract of land convey-
 ed by George & Cora Blumens to the said party
 34 of the first part and the W^{1/4} of S^{1/4} of Section 34
 33 and the E^{1/4} and the E^{1/2} of the S^{1/4} of Section 33
 21-2 W all in Township 21 of Range 2 West and the N^{1/4} of
 4-22 4 W E^{1/2} of N^{1/4} and the N^{1/4} of the S^{1/4} and the N^{1/4}
 of the E^{1/4} of Section 4 Township 22 of Range 2 West
 all that tract of land conveyed to party of the first
 part by William and Zada Barker and the
 following named negro Slaves to wit Elvira a
 Girl about 14 years old Parmelia Mioduna a
 Girl about 13 years old John a man about 43
 years old John a boy about 19 years old and
 Tilda a woman wife and tithes Carry a boy
 about 5 years old To have and to hold in
 trust as follows first that the said party of the
 first part be permitted to hold the possession
 and use of said property during his natural
 life then in the event that Lewis McCleendon be
 living that he said Lewis McCleendon have a
 support and maintenance for his life in comfort
 out of said property then that the said party
 of second part conveyed all of said land except
 foot acres herein after described to David
 Mahan & Erwin Mahan two sons of Joseph
 Mahan as the survivor of them and in the

event that neither of them should then be living that
 in that event the same be sold and the proceeds
 divided between Bessell McFlendon and Byron
 McFlendon and Dennis McFlendon in equal parts
 as to their descendants also that at my death
 the two negro girls Elvira and Parthenia Star-
 =den be sold and out of the proceeds thereof
 that the said parties of the second part pay
 five hundred dollars to Eleanor McFlendon
 daughter of James & Jane McFlendon and five
 hundred dollars be paid to Eleanor O. McFlendon
 daughter of Bessell and Nancy McFlendon the
 balance to be divided equally divided between
 Nancy McFlendon daughter of Byron McFlendon
 and Elvira Williams and all the wagons Car-
 =riages four horses one mule four oxen all
 the cattle hogs sheep goats and stock of every
 description house hold and kitchen furniture
 are also hereby conveyed in trust that the
 same at the death of the party of the first part be
 given to James McFlendon for his lifetime at his death
 to be equally divided between Byron McFlendon
 Bessell McFlendon and Dennis McFlendon as
 their descendants That at the death of the party of the
 first part the said parties of the second part convey
 to Charles Barnett husband of the said party of
 the first part the $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 of
 Township 21 of Range 3 East and that my interest
 estate is hereby conveyed should there be any
 thing left out the same is hereby conveyed and
 subject to the trust herein expressed given under
 my hand and seal this day and year above
 written
