

State of Alabama County of Shelby This Indenture made and Entered into on this the 24 day of September A.D. 1858. between James W. Gamble of said County and State of the first part and Thomas S. Morrow of said County and State of the 2 part Witnesses that the said Gamble being justly indebted to the said Morrow in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars evidenced by three judgments rendered in a Justice Court for said County before one Daniel W. Pringle an Acting Justice of the Peace for said County and for forty & 60/100 dollars besides Costs rendered on the 28 day of February 1857. An other for forty & 50/100 dollars besides Costs rendered on the 28 day of February 1857 the other for fourteen & 22/100 dollars besides Costs rendered on the 28 day of February 1857. And the said Gamble being anxious and desirous of securing the said Morrow in the payment of said judgments has this day conveyed sold and Conveyed and by these Presents do convey sell and Convey unto the said Morrow his heirs and assigns forever the following described property to wit all my present growing Crop of Cotton and Corn a portion of which has been gathered to hand and to hold unto the said Morrow his heirs and assigns forever now if the said Gamble pay off and discharge said judgments on or by the 25 day of December 1858 then this Conveyance to be void but should said Gamble make default in the payment of said judgments or any part of all or either of them on or by the 25 day of December 1858 then said Morrow is hereby authorized & empowered to seize and take

immediate possession of said property and after giving ten days notice in writing posted up in Courtrooms in said County & State proceed to sell to the highest bidder for Cash said property and Out of the proceeds of said sale pay off and discharge said judgments and the Costs of this Commission in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the day and year above written - J. W. Gamble Seal
