

This Indenture made entered into the 23 day of
 October A.D. 1838 between Joseph W Adams of the
 first part & William Ogley of the second part
 both of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama
 Witnesseth that whereas the said William Ogley is
 the Security for said J W Adams and a bond
 for his appearance at the Circuit Court of said
 County to answer the State of Alabama in an
 indictment for delivering Spurious papers to a
 Slave Edward the property of N B Blacking (he
 having become his Security on four several
 bonds an only one of which the Grand Jury
 found a bill) and the said Joseph W Adams
 being anxious & desirous to secure the said Wm Ogley
 against any loss by reason of his Securityship now
 due for in consideration of the sum of one dollar
 to him in hand paid the said party of the first
 part has this day bargained & sold by these
 presents do bargain & sell to the said Wm
 Ogley the following described notes viz an note
 of Hezekiah B. Jagg & Elias Moore for fifty dollars
 due 23rd December next and note of Thomas
 Ogley for Ten 15th 1840 dollars due 23rd December next
 and note of John Nash for about eight
 dollars due at some time and note of
 Amos M. Elliott for about fifteen dollars and
 note of Richmond Butler for twenty dollars
 due some time to have and to hold forever
 in the following Conditions viz that if said Wm
 Adams shall protect said Ogley from any
 loss by reason of his said Securityship & shall
 pay to said Ogley two dollars which the said
 Ogley has agreed to secure then the said
 notes to be returned to said Adams but
 should said Ogley become in any way
 liable by reason of his said Securityship
 & should said Adams fail to pay to said
 Ogley said sum of two dollars then the

said Ogley shall be and is hereby authorized
 & empowered to collect said notes by suit or other
 means with the proceeds of said notes pay off
 & satisfy whatever he may become liable for
 by reason of his said Deputyship & also to pay
 said Deputys said sum of ten dollars & the
 expenses of the Conveyance Given under
 our hand & Seal the day and year above
 written
