Ponder of said County and State of the second part Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand seven hundred and seventy five dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following real estate to wit the North East quarter and the East half of the North East quarter & the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section eleven (11) of Township twenty two (22) of Range third West and all that part of the East half of the South West quarter of Section two Township twenty two (22) Range third West lying in the West side of the Public road leading from Mountville in said County and State to Ash Grove Station in said State containing in all three hundred and fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the

hereditarily and appurtenances; thence to belong to
 have and to hold unto the said party of the
 second part his heirs and assigns executors and
 administrators forever. And the said party of
 the first part do hereby Covenant and agree
 to and with the said party of the second part
 that they are in quiet and peaceable possession of
 said premises and that they will forever warrant
 and defend the title to the said premises unto
 the said party of the second part his heirs
 and assigns forever against the claims or
 claims demand and demands of any and all
 persons whatsoever lawfully claiming in same.
