

This indenture made the 19th day of November AD 1858 between William Guy & Robert Guy of Shelby County Ala of the first part and James M Kellogg of said County & State of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part is duly indebted in the sum

of one hundred forty five dollars due on
 Arley the first day of September 1839 induced
 by three promissory notes for forty five
 dollars each bearing even date herewith which
 the party of the 1st part is anxious to secure
 to the said party of the second part
 Now in Consideration of the promises and
 for the further Consideration of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the party of the
 second part the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged hereby Grant Lequins and
 Jilly unto the said party of the second
 part the following described property to wit
 one bay horse about nine or ten years
 of age and one saddle horse about eleven
 or twelve years of age and the interest
 Corp to be raised in the year 1839 by the
 said parties of the first part Edward and
 to hold unto the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns forever

In Trust However that the said party of the
 1st part having possession of said horses
 & Corp till default be made in payment
 of said debt by said party of the first
 part But if default be made in paymen-
 t of said debt then said party of the
 second part shall be authorized to sell
 and sell said property at public sale
 giving twenty days notice by advertisement
 at the public places and appropriate
 the proceeds of said sale first to the pay-
 ment of the said debt and interest and
 the Cost of this trust and the remainder
 if any pay to the said party of the first
