

This Indenture Made and entered into the 11th day of
 August A.D. 1836 between Hudson Wilson as late Sheriff
 of the County of Shelby in the State of Alabama of the one
 part and Thomas S. Williams of the County and State
 aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the
 17th day of March 1837 Judgment was duly rendered in
 the Circuit Court for Shelby County in the State aforesaid
 for the sum of one hundred & forty eight \$/100
 dollars & legal Costs in favor of Hiram Butters
 against George M. Randall on which said Judgment
 due thereon was issued by the Clerk of the Circuit
 Court for said County a writ of Fieri facias in
 favor of said Hiram Butters against said George
 M. Randall directed to any Sheriff of the State of
 Alabama whereby such Sheriff was directed to
 levy of the estate of said George M. Randall the
 sum of one hundred & forty eight \$/100 dollars
 damages & legal Costs & which said writ was
 placed in the hands of H. Wilson as Sheriff
 of said County for the purpose of its levy

execution And whereas also on the 18th day of March
 1834 Judgment was duly rendered in the Circuit
 Court of Shelby County for the sum of Two hundred
 and thirty nine $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars including Costs in favor
 of Edmond King vs George M Randall and Robert B
 Wilson and which said Judgment execution was
 issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said
 County in favor of said King against said
 defendants directed to any Sheriff of the State of
 Alabama directed him to levy of the estate
 of said debt the sum of Two hundred thirty
 nine $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars damages including Costs and which
 said Execution was placed in the hands of said
 Nelson Sheriff as aforesaid And whereas also on
 the 15th September 1834 Judgment was duly rendered
 in the Circuit Court of Shelby County in favor of
 Edmond King & against George M Randall & course
 in hand for the sum of one hundred & five
 dollars damages including Costs and which said
 Judgment execution was duly issued & placed
 in the hands of A M Nelson as Sheriff of said
 County for the purpose of its levy & execution;
 And whereas also Judgment was duly rendered
 in the Circuit Court of Shelby County on the 15th day
 of September 1834 in favor of Butler & Symonds
 against George M Randall for the sum of
 Seventy and $\frac{1}{2}$ dollars damages including Costs
 and which said Judgment execution was duly
 issued & placed in the hands of A M Nelson
 as Sheriff of said County for the purpose of
 its levy & execution And whereas said Hudson
 M Nelson as Sheriff aforesaid after the said
 several Writs had come into his hands & while
 they were in full force did levy the same on
 the following land to wit The South half of the North East
 quarter of Section 20 in Township twenty four Range
 13 East also the South West quarter of the South East
 quarter the North West quarter of the South East
 quarter of Section 6 Township 24 Range 13 East also
 one third interest in the land known as the
 Acutt Land as the property of George M Randall
 (lying in Shelby County) And after having advertised
 said land for sale in the mode prescribed
 by law said several executions before the
 sale day of said land becoming returnable
 there was issued by the Clerk of said Court
 on the 12th day of March 1835 writs of sale and

each of said judgments Commanding said Sheriff to sell said land said Sheriff did in accordance with said advertisement in obedience to said Writ of sale on the 13th day of March A.D. 1835 in the town of Monteville proceeded to sell the same & the said Thomas Ellarson having bid for said land then and there selling at aforesaid the sum of five hundred & fifty five dollars at which the highest bid that could be then & there got for the same the said Nelson did therefore sell & convey the said land to the said Thomas Ellarson Now therefore in consideration of the premises the said party of the first part as aforesaid Sheriff of Shelby County has & does hereby convey & sell all and convey unto the said Thomas Ellarson the said land to wit the South half of the North East quarter of Section seven Town ship 34 Range 13 East also the South West quarter of the South East quarter & the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section 6 Township 34 Range 13 East also and thereunto vest in the land known as the South land lying in Shelby County To have and to hold the aforesaid land together with all & singular its appurtenances thenceforth belonging to the said Thomas Ellarson his heirs & assigns forever & the said party of the first part as aforesaid does Command with the said party of the second part that he as Sheriff as aforesaid will warrant the title to the said land so far only as he by virtue of his said Office is authorized to do but it is expressly understood that said Hudson Wilson is in no event to be individually liable for any thing herein contained
