Co land district to have and to hold to the said
second party his heirs and assigns forever the above
described and hereby granted lands and premises
and the said parties of the first part husband & wife
hereby Covenant with the said party of the 2 part
that We are lawfully seized of and have good right
to sell and Convey said land and hereby bind our-
selves our heirs and legal representatives forever to
Warrant and defend the title to said land and
premises to the said party of the 2 part his heirs assigns
and legal representatives against the Claim of all and
Every person in law or Equity and against the Gov-
ernment of the United States given under our ha-
nds and Seals this day and year above written
