 60/100 dollars due by promissory note bearing even
 date herewith he is anxious to secure to the said party
 of the 1st part now in consideration of the premises
 and for the further consideration of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the party of the 2^d part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hereby
 grants bargains & sells unto the said party of the 2^d
 part a Certain Sound house about 15 1/2 hands high
 about six years of age To have and to hold
 unto the said party of the 2^d part his heirs & assigns
 forever In test whereunto that the said party

of the 1st part have possession of said House till default be made in the payment of said debt by said party of the 2nd part but if default be made in payment of said debt then said party of 2nd part shall be authorized to buy and sell said house at public sale giving twenty days notice by advertisement at three public places and appropriate the proceeds of said sale first to the payment of the said debt and interest and then the Costs of this trust and the remainder of any pay to the said party of the first part in writing.
