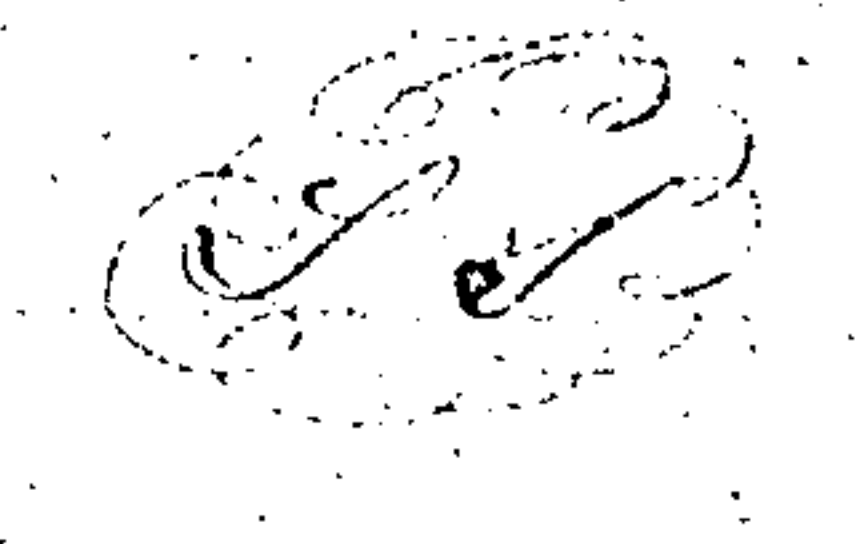
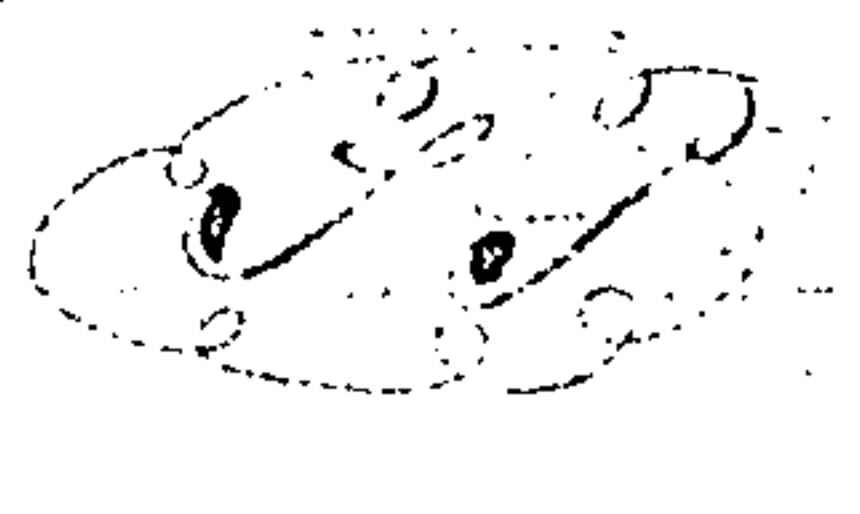


The State of Alabama, This indentured made and
