 & twenty five dollars to them in hand paid
 by the said party of the second part witnesses
 That the said parties of the first part for and
 in Consideration of the sum of one hundred &
 twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by
 the said party of the second part the receipt
 thereof is hereby acknowledged have sold and
 hereby sell Convey and Convey unto the said
 party of the second part the following described
 land lying in Shelby County State of Alabama
 to wit Commencing at the South East Corner of
 the lot in which John Wille Rae now lives on
 the Ryndge Road leading from Clumbeana
 and running North East (with said Road)
 one hundred and twenty one yards to the
 South West Corner of the lot in which East W.
 Goudick now lives on said Ryndge road
 and thence running South West (with Goudick's
 line one hundred and eighty three yards
 thence South West parallel with the first line
 to McRae's lot thence South East to the line
 containing four acres to land aid to Road to
 said second party his heirs and assigns
 possess the above described land hereby
 granted land and promises And the
 said parties of the first part husband and
 wife hereby Covenant unto the said party of
 the second part that now are lawfully seized
 of and have good right to sell and convey
 said land and hereby bound ourselves
 our heirs and legal representatives forever
 to warrant and defend the title to said
 land and promises to the said party of
 the said party of the second part his heirs

assigned and legal representations against the
 claims of all and every person in Law or Equity
 and against the Government of the United
