 day of December 1858 between G. Thompson of
 the first part & G. Thompson of the second
 part (Witnesseth that whereas the said party
 of the first part is indebted by promissory note
 of date with the instrument and due
 within month after date for the sum of
 seventy dollars to the said party of the second
 part and the said party of the first part being
 desirous to secure to the said party of the second
 part the above described amount from
 the same in consideration of the promise as
 well as the further sum of one dollar in
 hand paid the receipt whereof the said
 party of the first part does hereby acknowl-
 edge the said party of the first part hath

and hereby sells and conveys to the said party of the second part the following property to wit here
 after to be called Buggy & Harbors: to have and to hold in
 trust as follows: It is hereby agreed that if the
 said party of the first part shall fully pay
 or cause to be paid the said sum of sev-
 enty dollars and all reasonable charges for
 the recording of this instrument by the 1st day
 of Decr 1839 then this instrument is to be null
 & void otherwise should the said party
 of the first fail to pay said sum of money
 as above described then the said party
 of the second part is empowered to sign & take
 into his possession the above described prop-
 erty & after giving Ten days notice by advertise-
 -ment in the said papers for sale at those
 public places in said County sell the same
 to the highest bidder in the Town of Hesperwell
 and after paying the above described amounts
 pay over the balance if any to the said
 party of the first part In witness whereof on
