 of Shelby & State of Alabama of the one part and
 William Healy of the other part Witnesseth that the
 said Edman & his wife Sarah Healy for and in
 consideration of the sum of seven hundred & fourteen
 40,00 dollars doth in hand paid the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained sold
 aliened conveyed & conveyed & by these presents doth
 bargain sell convey & convey to the said William
 Healy all that certain tract or parcel of land lying &
 being in the County of Shelby & State of Alabama & known
 & distinguished in the plan of Survey of said State
 as the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17
 Township 20 Range 1 East and the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
 North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17 Township 20 Range 1 East
 The South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8 Township 20 Range
 1 East with the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17 Range 1
 East and the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17 Townsh-
 -ip 20 Range 1 East containing two hundred acres
 to have and to hold the above described tracts
 or parcels of land together with the
 improvements and appurtenances thereto belong-
 -ing or in any wise appertaining unto the said
 Edman Healy and the said Edman
