 lying & being in the County of Shelby & State of Alabama
 & known & described in the follow of Survey of
 said State as the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of Section 16 T³S³R³
 Range (1) East & 1st NW¹/₄ of) containing exactly the SW¹/₄
 of Section 9 Township 3rd Range 1st East containing
 eighty Acres To have & to hold the above described tract
 of land together with the timbering & appur-
 tenances thereunto belonging belonging as in any
 wise appertaining unto the said William Heatty &
 the said William Heatty his wife Mary Heatty their
 heirs and assigns forever their heirs executors
 & administrators doth warrant & will forever
 defend the title to the above described & hereby granted
 premises unto the said Coleman Heatty his heirs
 & assigns forever & against all persons call and
 every person claiming or holding under the said
 Coleman Heatty & also against the lawful claim
 or demand of all every person or persons
 claiming or holding by force or under the
 Government of the United States.
