

The State of Alabama, This indenture made and
 Shelly County, entered into this the eighteenth
 day of December one thousand eight hundred
 eighty eight between Mrs. A. B. B. of the first part
 J. H. Hill & Co of the second part all of the above
 named County and State. Witnesseth that
 Whereas the said party of the first part is duly
 entitled to the said party of the second part
 in the sum of one hundred and
 twenty six dollars and the said party of the

first part being disowned of Securing said party of the second part by giving them a Mortgage on a Cotton Broom or Sack Sack Horse and on his full Crop that he may make in the year AD 1839 said Crop to be gathered in due time & the Cotton to be delivered at N. Mendota or some other convenient place and if said party of the first part fails to deliver the above described Property by the first day of December AD 1839 then it shall be lawful for said party of the second part to take said Property into their possession and advertise the same few days and sell the same for cash and if said Property overpays said Wm A. Bogan's indebtedness to said party of the second part then said party of the second part shall refund said surplus to said Bogan as to his order. In testimony whereof these presents set my hand and seal day and year above mentioned. Wm A. Bogan L.B.
