 sold and by these presents doth bargain sell convey
 and Convey to the said Rufus Albright all that cer-
 -tain Tract or parcel of land lying and being
 in the County of Shulley and State of Alabama and known
 & distinguished in the plan of Survey of said State
 as the NW^{1/4} of the NW^{1/4} of Section 16 Township 20 Range
 1 East Containing forty acres to have and to hold the
 above described Tract or parcel of land together
 with the tenements appurtenances thereto belonging as
 in any wise appertaining unto the said William
 Healy and the said William Healy and his wife
 Mary Healy their heirs and assigns forever their
 heirs executors and administrators doth warrant
 & will forever defend the title to the above described
 and hereby Granted premises unto the said Rufus
 Albright his heirs and assigns forever and
 against all persons & all sorts of person claiming
 as holding under the said Rufus Albright and
 also against the lawful Claim or demand of all &
 every person or persons claiming as holding by
 colour or under the Government of the United
 States for Testimony whereof we have hereunto
 set our hands and seal this year and day
 above written
