

This Indenture made and returned into this the
 21st day of January A D 1839 between John P. West
 and Macarath E. his wife of the County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama of the first part and Columbus
 Cunningham of the same place of the second
 part testeth that the said parties of the first
 part for and in consideration of the sum of
 nine hundred dollars lawful money to
 them in hand paid by the said party of the
 second at as before the insuing and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 enfeoff and convey unto the said party of the
 second part and to his heirs and assigns
 forever all their interest in the following described
 tract or parcel of lands as conveyed to them by
 H. W. Nelson Sheriff of said Shelby County by a deed
 on the 26th day of July A D 1835 to wit the E 1/4
 of NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the E 1/4 of
 the NE 1/4 and the E 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 18 Township

of Nancy Cost against said Randall on the 29th
day of June 1835 and the said parties of the
first part Covenant and agree with the said
party of the second part that they will forever
warrant and defend their title as described in
the aforesaid premises from the Claim or
Claims of any person whatsoever and that they
will forever defend the said party of the second
part his heirs and assigns in the undisturbed
and peaceable possession as before described
of said premises In witness whereof we have
