 Shelby County 3 entered into this 26th day of
 January 1839 between Parach Williams debtor
 of the 1st part and Brasher & Coldwell Creditors
 of the second part Voluntarily That whereas
 the said party of the 1st part is justly indebted
 to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of one
 hundred & 0/100 dollars due by a promissory

Note made the 1st day of January 1837 and payable
 an or before the 1st day of January 1857 and the
 said party of the 1st part being desirous to secure
 the payment of said indebtedness for and in
 consideration thereof and for the further consideration
 of the sum of one dollar to the said party of the
 1st part in hand paid by the said party of the
 2d part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 the said party of the 1st part has sold and hereby
 sells and conveys to the said party of the 2d
 part the following described property to wit
 the NE 1/4 of the Sec. 2 & NW 1/4 of Sec. 4 the NW 1/4 of
 the Sec. 4 all in section 3 Township 4 N Range 13 East
 to have and to hold in trust as follows It is hereby
 agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to have
 and retain possession of the said property until
 the 1st day of January 1860 and if the said party
 of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of
 the 2d part said debt with the interest thereon and
 the reasonable expenses hereof by said 1st day of
 January 1860 then this Indenture is to be null
 and void But upon default of such payment
 the said party of the 2d part is hereby authorized
 to take into possession and sell said property
 to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten
 days notice of the time and place of said sale
 by advertisement posted up at the public places
 and out of the proceeds of said sale to pay the
 said sum of one hundred & 87/100 dollars and
 interest thereon and the reasonable costs hereof and
 the balance if any pay to the said party of the 1st
 part upon and free of said Land & H Savings.
 has already a deed of trust to secure the payment
 of a debt due from William to him which has
 precedence in said land over the deed of trust
 Given under our hands and seals this day and
 year above written Baruch Williams &
 Brasher Caldwell
