

The State of Massachusetts This indenture made and
 Shilley County 3 entered into this 29 day of Jan-
 uary 1859 between John Todd debtor of the 1st
 part and William Baker Creditor of the second
 part Witnesseth That whereas the said party of the
 1st part is justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part in
 the sum of one hundred & thirty dollars by promissory
 note of this day and legible and as before the 25th day
 of December 1859 and the said party of the first part
 being desirous to secure the payment of said indebted-
 ness for and in consideration thereof and for
 the further consideration of the sum of one dollar
 to the said party of the first part in hand paid
 by the said party of the 2nd part the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged the said party of the 1st part
 has sold and hereby sells and conveys to the said
 party of the 2nd part the following described property
 to wit One Gray horse the same day sold
 by Baker to said Todd to have and to hold in
 trust as follows: It is hereby agreed that the said
 party of the first part is to have and retain possession
 of the said property until the 25th day of December
 1859 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully
 pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt
 with interest thereon and the reasonable expenses
 made by said 25th day of December 1859 then this
 indenture is to be null and void But upon default

of such payment the said party of the 2nd part is hereby authorized to take into possession & sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving twenty days notice of the time & place of said sale & advertisement - posted up at three public places & out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of one hundred & thirty dollars & interest thereon & the reasonable costs hereof & the balance if any pay to the said party of the 1st part -
