And whereas the said F.B. Allen is desirous of securing the payment of these debts and also the persons who have become bound for him on account of said debts as acceptors endorser or securities against loss in case they or either of them should be Compelled to pay any portion of their respective liabilities before the same can be provided for out of the means hereinafter conveyed in trust for that purpose. Now therefore in consideration of the premises and the sum of ten dollars to him in hand paid by the said Lee & Sawyer Trustees & he the said F.B. Allen hath this day granted bargained and sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Lee & Sawyer Trustees & the following described portions of his real & personal property (viz) "a certain piece of land lying in the town of Montevallo to wit the north east part of Lot No 19 in the plan of said town forty feet in width and two hundred & ninety six feet in length being the same piece of land on which the store house now occupied by said Allen is situated together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining" Also all the goods wares & merchandise now on hand in said store house amounting in value at least as is supposed (no account of said stock having been taken as yet) to the sum of about \$5.500⁰⁰ together with all the notes and accounts due to him said Allen from various persons which are included in a schedule hereto attached marked "Schedule A" amounting to the sum of \$6158 44. Which said schedule is hereby made part of this deed of trust as fully & effectually as though the same were here inserted at length. To have and to hold unto the said Medham Lee and Reason B. Sawyer Trustees & in fee simple forever And the said F.B. Allen covenants to & with said Lee & Sawyer Trustees & that he will forever warrant and defend the title to the property hereby conveyed. This conveyance however is upon the following express trusts viz The said Trustees shall take possession of said store house & lot together with the stock of goods wares & merchandise now on hand in said store & hereby conveyed together with the notes and accounts contained in "Schedule A" afo³ so soon as this deed is Executed

They shall proceed immediately with such Competent assistance as it may be necessary for them to employ for the purpose to take an account of said goods wares & Merchandise now on hand in said Store house stating the quantity of each article & its value in the usual manner of making out an account of stock - said Trustees shall then give notice by publication in the "Chronicle" a newspaper published in the County of Shetley. that they will sell said goods wares and Merchandise at private sale in said Store house at Cost for Cash or good paper on short time - If said Stock is not all sold out in this manner at the end of ninety days from the execution of this deed said Trustees shall then after giving ten days notice of the time of sale offer said remainder at public outcry to the highest bidder for Cash or good notes on short Credit as they may think more likely to secure the best prices said sale may be continued from day to day until the entire balance of said Stock not sold at private sale as aforesaid is disposed of said sale is to be conducted within the usual sale hours - the goods put up in such lots or quantities as will be likely to receive the best prices - The said Trustees shall also proceed to collect the notes and accounts conveyed to them by this deed with all convenient speed and they shall in all cases if possible when said accounts are not paid on presentation close the same by notes payable to them as Trustees & and they are hereby authorized and required to sue on all Claims which are now due if they are not promptly paid - They are however authorized to exercise a sound discretion in this matter for the purpose of more effectually securing the payment of the debts hereby secured. If said Trustees should be of opinion that the interest of the persons secured by this deed will be furthered & the object of this trust more certainly & speedily accomplished by a public sale as hereinbefore provided of the remaining portion of said goods they are hereby authorized after having offered them as aforesaid at private sale for thirty days after the completion of the inventory or account of stock aforesaid to commence selling them at public outcry in the manner & on the terms hereinbefore indicated they having first given the ten days notice of said sale hereinbefore required. This notice may be given by them in advance of the expiration

of the thirty days if in their judgment they should think it best so that the public sale may commence at once on the expiration of the thirty days aforesaid. The said Trustees shall keep the inventory of goods wares & merchandise to be made by them subject to the examination of any of the parties to this deed or of any other Creditor of the grantor at all reasonable times - The said Trustees shall employ such competent persons to assist them as Clerks & bookkeepers as may be necessary to execute this trust faithfully to the best advantage - They the said trustees being responsible for their actings and doings in the premises - And the expenses thus incurred together with such other expense as may be necessary to the proper execution of this deed they are authorized to pay (the same being reasonable) out of the property or its proceeds which is hereby conveyed. And the said Trustees shall apply the money as fast as the same can be collected (less expenses as aforesaid) to the payment of the debts hereinbefore specified pro Rata - And the said Trustees are to make said pro Rata payments as soon and as often as the diligent execution of this trust will enable them to do it. And they are to take receipts or vouchers for all payments showing the amount & time of payment on what account & by whom made. The said Trustees shall advertise the sale of the store house & lot aforesaid for thirty days in said newspaper & shall sell the same at the door of said store house at public outcry for cash or according to the terms of the advertisement, within the usual sale hours - This sale to be made as soon as the interests of this trust require it in the judgment of said Trustees and the proceeds when collected shall be applied pro Rata to payment of the debts hereinbefore enumerated & provided for in manner aforesaid - If after paying the debts in manner & form as herein provided there is any balance left in the hands of said trustees the same shall be accounted for by them according to law to the person or persons entitled by law to receive the same. And the said Trustees are hereby clothed with all the powers & authority necessary & proper for the due and legal execution of this trust - And the said Abraham Lee for himself & the said Reuben B. Sawyer

for himself Covenants to & with the said F. B. Allen
 with the said beneficiaries in this trust each of them
 to execute the same in good faith to the best of their
